Thank you for entering the Alexandra Road Seal Hillclimb. Your entry has been accepted. The following includes important information.

#### **Documentation and Scrutineering**

Documentation and Scrutineering is from **11:00am** to **1:00pm** on **Saturday 16 March** at Racetech, 18 Barnes Street, Seaview, Lower Hutt. Please be considerate when parking and maneourvering. Do not park anywhere that blocks access to any driveway etc. Documentation will be in the Showroom and Scrutineering will be in the front of the building.

If you are not able to make it on Saturday, please call or email so arrangements can be made for you to complete the process on Sunday morning at the venue, between 8:00am and 8:30am, prior to Drivers Briefing.

## All drivers must produce the following at Documentation / Scrutineering:

- Protective Helmet and Overalls that are to be used during competition, including any to be used by passengers.
- Fire Extinguisher.
- Tyres intended for use at the event
- Log Book (if you car has one).

Remember, any driver wishing to take passengers must have their car scrutineered to do so.

Be prepared to show your race licence, club membership, and civil licence at Documentation if requested.

### Pit Parking

Please place all trailers in the parking area shown on the attached plan, to allow enough space in the pit area.

#### **Fuel Handling**

It is highly recommended that vehicles are not refuelled at the event. Being a short course there should be no need to do this. If refuelling is required then this must be done in the pits and in accordance with the MSNZ Code of Practice for the safe handling and transport of fuel. #### **Protective Clothing**

Competitors are reminded of the clothing requirements. You and any passengers are required to have a minimum of either double layer overalls or single layer with 100% cotton or wool underwear. There are also minimum requirements for socks and shoes.
