Plus we will tighten up the right hand kink before the old chest hospital by the use of barriers and cones, so that speeds are lower through the right hander at the chest hospital and into the tightening left hander afterwards. Plus, as we have done before we will have a visible barrier around the first part of the dipper, so you know where the corner is as you come up the hill, and hopefully not be inclined to shoot through it.
