### **MSNZ Conference and AGCM**

Jody Seabright and Bernie Keith represented the club at this years conference. While there was a lot of talk about various things, some key points to come out were.....

The ongoing work of the Training and Volunteer Commission with continuing work on providing training for volunteers and officials that is standardised nationally and potentially recognised overseas.

This training also extends to driver training and the purchase of high tech simulators to allow people new to the sport to have a go.



These simulators will be travelling the country and hopefully visiting our area later this year. This has been done with money provided by the FIA for our training programmes.

A remit was passed that means there will be an independent review of the sport's structure and it's governance model to see how it can be improved and made more relevant to today's environment. So it will be interesting to see how this pans out, especially with all the ructions and murmurings of recent times.

The wording in the new Motorsport Manual No 35 has changed in a number of areas, so it will be best to ensure that you read it carefully before you go out to compete next.
