Leicester Banfield

It is with sadness that we have to report Leicester passed away recently. A number of present and passed members made a fitting farewell, both personally and from the club. Don McLean has kindly written the following words.

Leicester was a very active WCC member from the late 1970's onwards. Known for some very enthusiastic drives in cars ranging from Vauxhall Victors (Victims!) Anglias, Zephyrs, Cortinas, an RX2 - even a Mark 10 Jaguar at an Autocross from memory. LB drove a lightweight Mini in sprint events doing well especially at venues like Rallywoods. I recall him organising events like south Makara sprint. The 12 hour production race at Manfield was another success - he bought a Barina GTI winning his class with participation from many WCC helpers. He co drove for lan Jensen in the Escort and developed his Silvia Turbo which he raced competitively.

LB fought an 8 year battle with cancer maintaining his incredibly optimistic outlook on life, passing away on the 20th of May. LB RIP.

MSNZ AGCM

Held on 21st and 22nd May, the annual meet and bleat was for once an interesting affair. The hottest topic was ban on using AvGas in all events from 1 July this year. After much debate, both in the conference and over a beer, the ban has remained in place and you will not be able to use AvGas at any event from then on. Genuine historic cars can still use leaded fuel through the Certificate Of Description (COD) system. But for the rest of us it will be unleaded fuels from here on in.

A new Training and Safety Commission has been established to provide training to marshals and officials. About \$250,000 has been provided from the FIA (from the money McLaren F1 was fined) to set up a full training system, so it needs to meet their standards and requirements. Look for more info as this progresses.

Oh, and the Gold Star Hillclimb Championship has been reinstated. Now separate from the Clubsport Championship, it will consist of two rounds in each island, with a final in one island (alternating each year). Each round will consist of a gravel and seal hillclimb on the same weekend. So it is now a significant and challenging title to contest each year, with a Gold Star awarded at the MSNZ black tie awards night.

Also it was a great pleasure to see Chris Parker honoured by MSNZ at the Awards. Chris started doing a results system for our club when we ran the Ohakune Rally all those years ago. He has continually improved that to the point where Asia Pacific Rallies now want him to run their results. You may know him as Chrissport for your rally results on line. Well done and a big thanks from WCC to Chris for all of his hard work and dedication.
